

## DID YOU KNOW?

Mesopotamia Delicatessen, which opened in mid-2015 at 3420 Lauderdale Drive, is a grocery and deli that relocated from its original location in Baghdad. Owner Hummam al Nageeb moved the eatery and store to Richmond after relocating his family to the city. You can't beat obtaining authentic Middle Eastern fare straight from the source and the delicatessen serves items including kebabs and shawarma.

## RECREATION

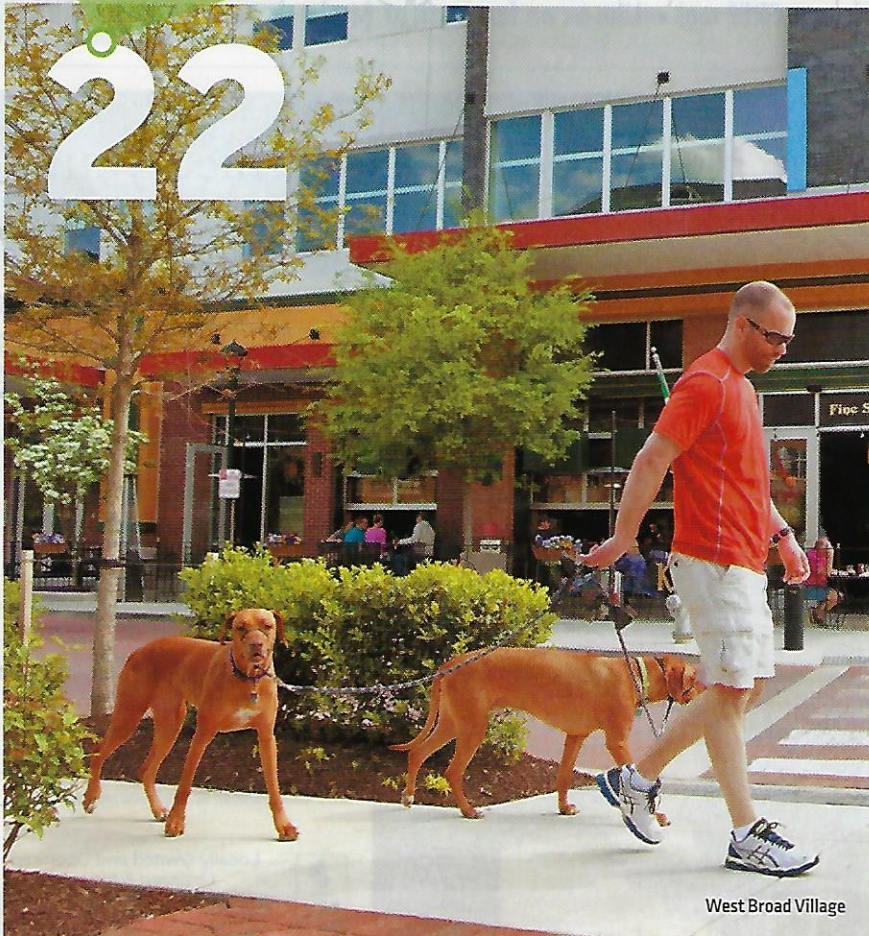

## LOOKING FORWARD

GreenGate, the Markel/Eagle mixed-use development, is scheduled to open in late 2016. The development near Short Pump Town Center will include the second location of the Carytown restaurant The Daily Kitchen & Bar. Another Carytown eatery, Mellow Mushroom, will also open a new location at GreenGate. Located on the 75-acre Nuckols Farm property, 300 residential units comprised of a mix of townhomes and single-family homes are also being constructed.

## SHOPPING

Short Pump Town Center, the region's destination outdoor mall, has acquired recent additions including L.L. Bean (the first in Richmond), the Short Pump location of the Children's Museum of Richmond, and the newest location of The Boathouse restaurant. Can't find it at Short Pump? Try one of a number of shopping centers that now ring the massive mall and provide homes to boutiques and big-box stores. Just off Parham Road is another retail corridor, anchored by Regency Square Mall.

## THE VIBE

Part of the Far West End, this area is a mix of prestigious suburban communities and older developments that have smaller lots but the benefit of convenient city access. Neighborhoods with rolling hills and charming gardens are as common here as luxury condos and townhouses.

## ENTERTAINMENT

The Children's Museum of Richmond-Short Pump relocated to Short Pump Town Center in mid-2015 with expanded exhibits including a soy bean farm and virtual play floor geared toward those younger than 8. Funny Bone at Short Pump Town Center has a rotating schedule of comedians. The Tin Pan, a new restaurant and listening room near Regency Square Mall, features local, regional and national musical acts.
