

## DID YOU KNOW?

Goochland's annual Field Day of the Past began in 1992 as a meeting of about 5,000 steam- and gas-engine enthusiasts. Today that gathering has grown into a weekend of historical and cultural activities highlighting the past of the county and drawing more than 40,000 people. From young to old, there are activities to please everyone including tractor pulls, living history exhibits, crafts and vendors, carnival rides, animal exhibits and more.

### ENTERTAINMENT

The only drive-in movie theater in the metro area is in Hadensville, the Goochland Drive-in Theater. It offers a classic outdoor movie experience, and shows run from spring until fall, with a few Christmas movie nights thrown in for holiday fun. In September, the Field Day of the Past offers a mini-state fair. Grayhaven Winery plays host to the South African Food and Wine Festival annually. White Hawk Tavern & Music is a comfortable spot to grab a meal, socialize, take a music lesson, and listen to live music.

### THE VIBE

Rural life remains king out here, though development is working its way into the county, which ranks as one of the wealthiest per capita in the United States. To be sure, there are a few charming established neighborhoods near Goochland Court-

house and Tuckahoe Plantation that you don't have to be a country squire to afford, but high-end developments like Kinloch, on a lake near Route 288, offer luxe amenities along with elegant homes.

### RECREATION

The James River provides great tubing and fishing through Goochland. A popular route is the Westview to Maidens float. Goochland's quiet country roads and rolling hills are also popular with cyclists.

### SHOPPING

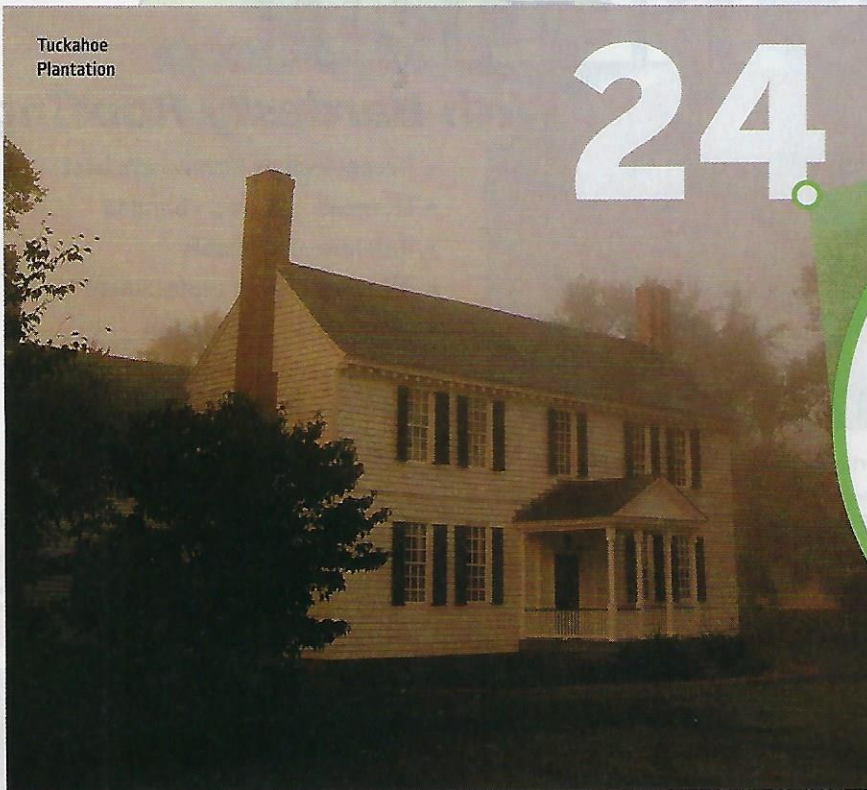
Chiknegg's My Manakin Market is a Saturday can't-miss in Manakin-Sabot from May through October. Fresh produce, local artists and crafters, and plenty of atmosphere make the market an event rather than just a grocery-shopping trip.

### LOOKING FORWARD

The West Creek area of Goochland has been experiencing a development boom with more projects planned in the coming months. Recently, the county's first multifamily housing project opened, the Retreat at West Creek. The West Creek Business Park will house the second location of Hardywood Park Craft Brewery complete with a 60,000-square-foot brewery, packaging and distribution hall, taproom, beer garden, amphitheater and more. The \$28 million brewery complex's first phase is estimated to be completed mid-2017. It's the latest addition to the area that also includes the recent and under construction developments of the Medarva Medical Center, Wegmans grocery store and Cabela's outdoor outfitter.
