DID YOU KNOW?

French Huguenots, fleeing religious persecution, settled the area in the late 17th century. It was they who discovered, in 1701, the massive Richmond Coal Basin, running through much of the county.

THE VIBE

Abutting the western edge of the city, this area rolls along the James River out to the border with Powhatan County in handsome neighborhoods, some of which take advantage of the river. Access all over the region is a breeze with Midlothian Turnpike at its southern edge, the Powhite Parkway to the east and Route 288 to its west. Single-family homes on wooded lots dominate, and classic neighborhoods such as Salisbury continue to attract newcomers putting down roots.

SHOPPING

Bon Air offers neighborhood shopping convenience with Bon Air Seafood selling specialty items, along with antiques and collectible dealers. Chesterfield Towne Center rules the roost on Midlothian Turnpike, with an H&M opening this past fall. To the west, Westchester Commons adds retail, restaurants and events. Several

Midlothian Turnpike shopping centers have antiques dealers, malls and consignment spots for one-of-a-kind finds.

ENTERTAINMENT

May's Victorian Day Festival and Parade in Bon Air celebrates the old-time charms of this former resort area, which once provided a lovely respite from the city with convenient rail service.

RECREATION

This area boasts golf courses that appeal to members and guests alike, from the public links at Independence Golf Club, home of the Virginia State Golf Association, to the private course at Salisbury Country Club. Robious Landing Park offers trails and boating access to the James River. In addition, the Virginia Boat Club has a boathouse for rowers in the area, and they offer instruction along with recreational and competitive rowing programs.

BON AIR, MIDLOTHIAN

Abundant, lush neighborhoods are tucked away behind shopping destinations such as Sycamore Square and Chesterfield Towne Center.

LOOKING FORWARD

When it opens this spring in Stonehenge Village, the new Midlothian Wegmans will create 550 part-time and full-time jobs. The grocery chain will open another local store at the West Broad Marketplace in Short Pump.
